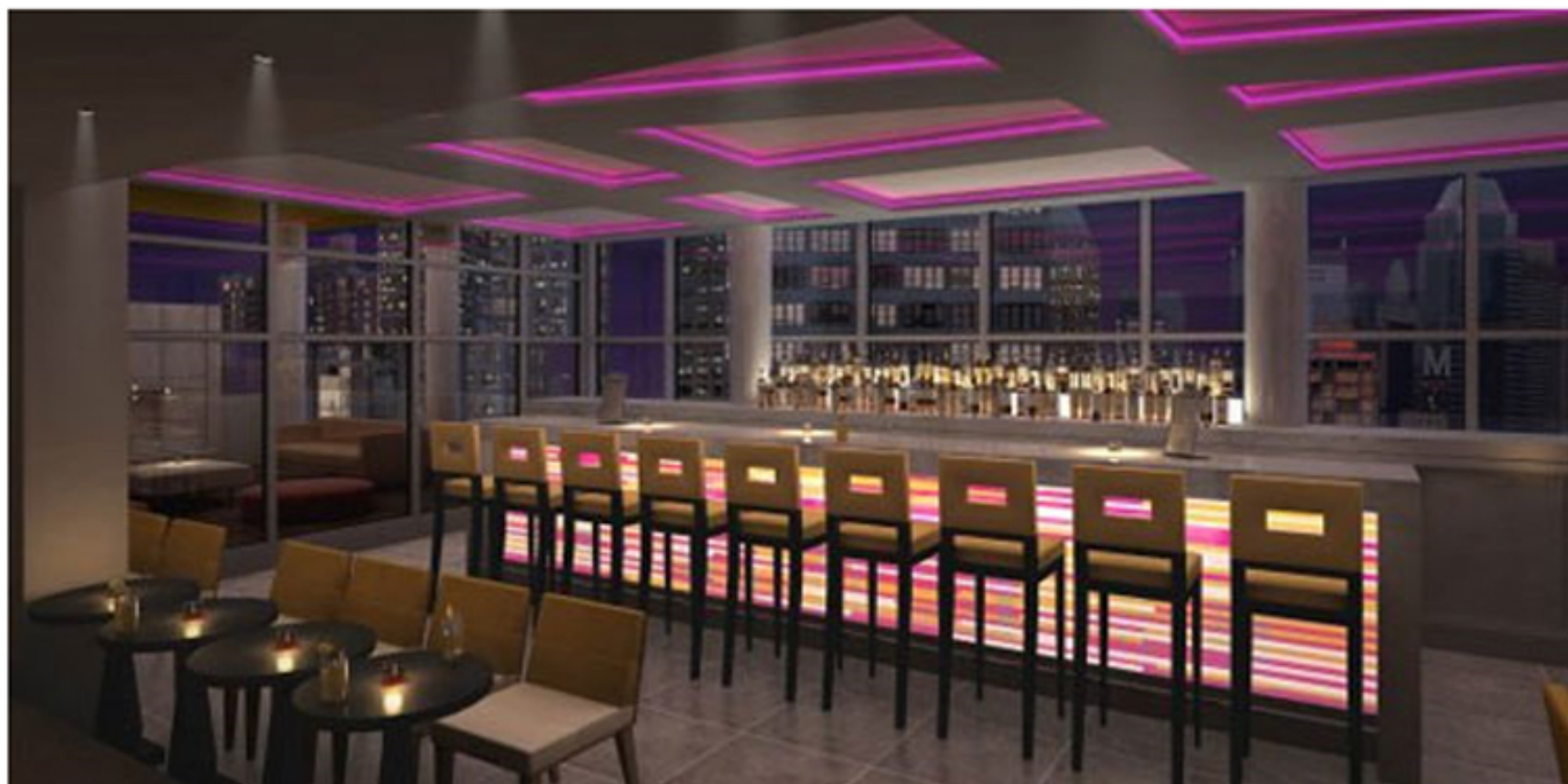


## The Sky Room

While we admire any hotel that makes an attempt at a rooftop lounge, many do so badly. But, coming this May, there will be a bigger, higher (actually, *the highest rooftop lounge in New York City*) rooftop spot in a very sweet locale indeed. Taking up the 33rd and 34th floor of the new *Marriott Fairfield Inn and Suites Times Square* will be the new *Sky Room*, providing area dwellers and hotel guests with a 360 degree view of Manhattan and the Hudson River. The space will have nooks dubbed the North and South terrace, Cube balcony, private salon and the Times Square Lounge. Architect *Stephen B. Jacobs* with interior designer *Andi Pepper* are the brains behind the bi-level project, slated to open late May.

The North terrace on the first level will feature glass walls with glass retractable roof, while the South terrace will have illuminated furniture, lit floor tiles, all atop the rooftop patio (don't look down). Think futuristic '90's mixed with urban nightlife colors. Expect the interior to look chic and (hopefully) not too over-the-top. Once open, the *Sky Room* will certainly have that mandatory specialty cocktail list, seasonal food menu and expect a DJ-driven house of sound.
